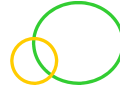

Our focus is to help youth and families find solutions and alternatives to living and leading a better future. With every family comes a new day, a new experience and another opportunity for a new start to an improved life.

In our programs, we treat youth and families to strengthen and stabilize them by helping them find their strengths and methods to communicate more effectively. Additionally, we empower youth to take responsibility for their actions and encourage self-esteem. For parents, we create a common ground so parents also understand the results of their actions and the effects it has on their children.

Annie Malone's commitment to families are to keep children safe while supporting them when in need.

## IMPROVING LIVES

Our Mission is to improve the quality of life for children, families, the elderly and the community, by providing social services, educational programs, advocacy and entrepreneurship in the St. Louis metropolitan community.



Our services are offered to families who often have no other support. The most common reasons families turn to Annie Malone includes:

- Overwhelmed with Stress
- Abuse, Neglect, Abandonment (Homelessness)
- Terminal Illness or death in family
- Lack of clothing, food, or shelter
- Community Referrals and Resources
- Emergency Placements

Where appropriate, family members are included in all phases of assessment, planning, and treatment of the child.



## HELPING KIDS AND FAMILIES

### ANNIE MALONE PROGRAMS

**Crisis Intervention, Respite & Emergency Services** provides a safe 24 hour environment for children birth to 18 with intervention measures to immediately alleviate crisis by providing emergency shelter, food, clothing, educational needs, conflict resolution, emergency medical attention, counseling referrals, to prevent child abuse and neglect. The program helps to reduce parental stress improve family communication skills, and prevent future crisis.

**Transitional Living Program (TLP)** provides youth between the ages of 16 and 21 the necessary skills to successfully transition to independent, productive adults through a series of personal training and life skills development. Living Arrangements include a supervised group home and independent living scattered site apartments.

**Emerson Academy Therapeutic School** promotes successful learning behaviors and outcomes for students, grades K-12 with Individual Education Plans (IEP's). Students that are successful with therapeutic programming will be able to return to their regular school environment and excel to the next academic level.



**Parenting Education** provides a seven week instruction based environment to re-establish and promote healthy relationships between parents and children. The course is designed to help prevent child abuse, successfully raise and appropriately discipline children.
